


WELCOME TO TANGLEWOOD

Bring the magic and history of Tanglewood to your next event.

Tanglewood has been the summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra since 1937. Comprising more than 400 acres of landscaped grounds, formal gardens, and rolling meadows in the towns of Lenox and Stockbridge, Tanglewood was once the country estate of Boston banker William Aspinwall Tappan. The Property, including the Main House which is still in use today, was given to the Boston Symphony Orchestra by Tappan's daughter, Mary, and her niece Mrs. Gorham Brooks. Although Tanglewood welcomes more than 300,000 visitors each year, its beauty and tranquility remain unchanged.

Seranak



SERANAK

Seranak offers a magnificent setting for the various artistic and social gatherings that support the vibrant life of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. Offering magnificent views of Lake Mahkeenac (Stockbridge Bowl), Seranak sits on 170 acres and was built in 1913. After leading the BSO's first concerts in the Berkshires some three years earlier, Serge Koussevitzky purchased the property in 1939, and in 1940, founded the Berkshire Music Center, now the Tanglewood Music Center. Today, Seranak remains much the same as when the Koussevitzkys resided here. In the music room, there is a life-sized portrait of Koussevitzky playing the double bass, the instrument on which he was a virtuoso prior to his conducting days. His study abounds with historic photographs and letters, along with a plaster cast of his left hand positioned to play the double bass.

Highwood



HIGHWOOD

Highwood, one of the earliest of the famous Berkshire estates, includes a twenty-room manor house that was built in 1846. The BSO acquired the 120 acres of Highwood in 1987, and under a master plan designed by the firm of Carr, Lynch, Hack & Sandell, the adjoining Highwood and Tanglewood estates were rejoined into the single entity they were originally. Highwood Manor is now used to serve dinner on Friday and Saturday, and brunch on Sunday, during the Tanglewood season, and is also available for private functions seasonally. The views across the lawn to the Stockbridge Bowl are breathtaking, and the manor house itself can accommodate up to 150 people, with the option of renting an outdoor tent to increase capacity to 450 people.

RENTAL TENTS AT TANGLEWOOD

Renting a tent is a great way to keep your guests comfortable rain or shine. We offer rentals of the Hawthorne Tent, near the Whispering Bench (seated dinner capacity: 400) or Formal Gardens Tent, near the Copland Ellipse (seated dinner capacity: 100), with breathtaking views of the Berkshire Mountains. Additionally, on each end of the Tanglewood summer season, we offer the Tent Club (seated dinner capacity: 400) and a variety of tent sizes can be rented next to the historic Highwood Manor House.



LINDE CENTER FOR MUSIC AND LEARNING

This four-building complex with flexible event and meeting spaces, a 150-seat Café, and state-of-the-art technology is climate-controlled and available for your event beginning Fall 2019. The largest space accommodates a wide variety of social and dining events with a seating capacity of 250, and performances, lectures, meetings, film screenings, and recording sessions with customizable seating layouts. A lobby area with restrooms and an enclosed walkway connect this studio with the Café. Two smaller studios provide additional space for multi-room or progressive events, and other educational and social activities. The Linde Center for Music and Learning is located on the Tanglewood grounds in close proximity to Ozawa Hall.

The grounds of Tanglewood provide a variety of options to host the ideal wedding. Outdoor spaces feature the idyllic grounds of Tanglewood with views of the Stockbridge Bowl, manicured lawns, formal gardens, and beautiful shade trees. Additional options include a variety of tents available with everything you need to customize your event including tables, chairs, audio/visual equipment, golf carts, and more.


