BOSTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA ANNOUNCES CONDUCTOR AND PROGRAMMING CHANGES IN CONCERTS TAKING PLACE AT SYMPHONY HALL, NOVEMBER 11-13

Regrettably, conductor **Ton Koopman** has had to withdraw from his upcoming appearances with the Boston Symphony Orchestra, November 11, 12, and 13, at Symphony Hall, due to COVID-19 travel restrictions.



Replacing him will be American conductor **Roderick Cox** who will be making his BSO debut. As originally programmed, he will lead the BSO in Mozart's Clarinet Concerto, featuring BSO principal **William R. Hudgins** as soloist. Mr. Cox will also conduct the BSO in Mendelssohn's Symphony No. 3, *Scottish*, instead of Beethoven's Second Symphony.
